ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

On September 1, 1932, Mr. and Mrs. Harold W. Askins, Sr. purchased Chesnee Telephone Company of Chesnee, South Carolina to provide telephone services to the town of Chesnee and area communities in Spartanburg and Cherokee counties. The Company had approximately 60 stations. Mr. Askins became President and Treasurer, and Mrs. Askins became Vice President and Secretary. Mr. Askins died in 1965, and Mrs. Askins was appointed President and Treasurer. Their son, Harold "Bud" W. Askins, Jr., was appointed Vice President, and their daughter, Hannah Askins Lancaster, was appointed Secretary. Upon the death of Mrs. Askins in 1992, Hannah Askins Lancaster assumed the position of President and Treasurer, and Harold "Bud" W. Askins, Jr. was appointed Vice President and Chief Executive Officer. From 1992-2017 Hannah and her husband, Curt Lancaster, assumed the responsibility of the day-to-day operations and management of the company. The Askins and Lancaster families dedicated their lives to this company, investing in its growth and expansion into new services such as cable TV and Internet while generously supporting the local community. In 2017, Chesnee Communications, a family owned business for 85 years, was acquired by SkyLine Membership Corporation of West Jefferson, North Carolina. To honor the family's legacy of service as a communications provider and community benefactor, Chesnee Communications' parent company, SkyBest Communications, Inc., is honored to sponsor the SkyBest - Askins Legacy Scholarship to provide educational opportunities to deserving Chesnee High School students requiring financial assistance. The SkyBest - Askins Legacy Scholarship assists children of Chesnee Communications' customers who exhibit outstanding scholastic abilities and motivation with the cost of their education. Annually two scholarships will be presented: a \$1,000 College/University scholarship, renewable over four years for a total value of \$4,000 and a \$500 Community/Technical College scholarship, renewable over two years for a total value of \$1,000.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must:

- Be students whose parents are full-time residents in the Chesnee Communications service area and receive facilities-based service (telephone, internet or TV) from Chesnee Communications for a minimum of one year.
- Be graduating high school seniors (local public school, private school or home school) and reside full-time in the company's service area.
- Have qualified for entrance to a two-year community or technical college for the Community/Technical College Scholarship, or;
- Have qualified for entrance to a four-year college or university and have a minimum SAT score of 800 (critical reading and math) or a minimum ACT score of 19 (composite) for the College/University Scholarship.
- Be of college caliber in the judgment of their high school principal, counselor, scholarship committee or youth/ community leader.
- Provide documentation exhibiting financial need.
- Exhibit high scholastic achievement, leadership qualities, and participation in school/community activities.

NOTE: Children of Chesnee Communications' employees are ineligible for consideration.

HOW TO APPLY

Along with a completed scholarship application, please include the following:

- Complete high school transcript, including the results of all college entrance exams.
- Summary of applicant's extracurricular activities.
- Letter of application in the student's own handwriting.

- Letter of recommendation from the high school principal, guidance counselor, teacher, youth leader or community leader.
- Official information regarding other scholarship awards the student has applied for or received.
- Information demonstrating financial need.
- Recent individual digital or print photo to be used for publication. (Please do not attach using staples or paper clips to print photo.)
- Submit all application materials noted above to your public high school guidance department or Chesnee Communications.

AWARD PROCEDURES

- Students attending local public schools will submit applications to their guidance department; students attending private school or home school will submit applications directly to Chesnee Communications. All applications will be reviewed, and nominees for each of the two- and four-year scholarships will be selected based on eligibility requirements.
- Nominees will be interviewed individually at Chesnee Communications Office by the scholarship and award committee.
- A company official will present the scholarship recipients at their school on awards day and a public announcement of the recipients will be made following the awards event.
